GENERAL REGULATIONS

The “Tallinn Trophy 2020” will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Ice Dance 2018, the Special Regulations for Single & Pair Skating and the Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2018 as well as all pertinent ISU Communications – for Novice Categories ISU Communication 2328 and all respective ISU Communications.

Participation in “Tallinn Trophy 2020” is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and relevant ISU Communication or any update of it. Entries may be accepted by clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations, associated with the ISU.

It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet must be filled in precisely by each Skater/Team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. ENTRY FEE

Single Skating with one program:	75€
Artistic	40€
Single Skating with two programs:	90€
Ice Dance all categories (per pair):	120€

Each club has to pay for its participants 100% of the total amount right after the entry form confirmation, by **November 15th, 2020**.

If Payment is not done by **November 15th, 2020** additional fee of 5€ will apply. Same principal will apply for late entries (does not apply to entry substitutions).

In case of cancellation the competitor has to inform the Organizer as soon as possible. No refund will be granted, entries can only be substituted by another skater if a cancellation occurs.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will take place at the ice rink. The time will be announced later. The exact time is announced in the First Information and Time Schedule.

MUSIC

Music must be recorded on CD-s and submitted at the time of accreditation. The music Medias must be of good quality and labeled clearly with the Competitor's name, Nation, category and the exact music time. Each program must be recorded on a separate disc. All CD-s will be returned to the team leader by the end of the competition at the ice rink.

ACCOMMODATION

All participants have to book and pay the accommodation by themselves.

The Organizer will make the room arrangements for INVITED officials only.

EXPENSES

All participants and teams must pay the accommodation and transportation themselves. Organizer will not cover any expenses of competitors.

OFFICIALS

Members are kindly requested to nominate the International/ISU JUDGE. The nomination of one substitute is appreciated. The final composition of the panels will be done after the close of entries and will be published to participating Member in time. Organizer will send invitation for officials from final composition. The Organizer

will cover the accommodation for INVITED officials only. Meals for invited officials will be provided at the ice-rink during the days of competition.

AWARDING

The three best-placed competitors in each event will be awarded with a trophy/medal and a diploma.

RESULTS

The result of all categories will be calculated with “New ISU Judging system” and published on competition website in live.

LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU Rule 119 the Organizer accepts no liability for injury, property loss or damages incurred by Competitors or Officials. The Organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition.

COVID-19 PANDEMIC

With the current pandemic situation (spread of SARS-CoV-2 virus) with COVID-19 pandemic some preventative measures will be taken by the OC to ensure security of all team members and staff during the competition:

- Hand sanitizers will be provided at the dressing rooms, at the Rink site and in the warm-up area;
- No parents will be allowed directly to the Ice Rink site;
- App members are requested to respect distance of 2 meters with other people.

Please keep yourself updated with the Health Board of the Republic of Estonia recommendations (<https://www.terviseamet.ee/en/covid19#RECOMMENDATIONS>) as well as applicable restrictions announced by the Estonian Government (<https://www.kriis.ee/en/coronavirus-and-healthcare>).

Team members and staff, that recently had a close contact to COVID-19 positive, have symptoms of an infection or have been traveling through risk countries (<https://vm.ee/en/information-countries-and-self-isolation-requirements-passengers>) are not allowed to attend the competition and must stay in the isolation in accordance with government requirements.
